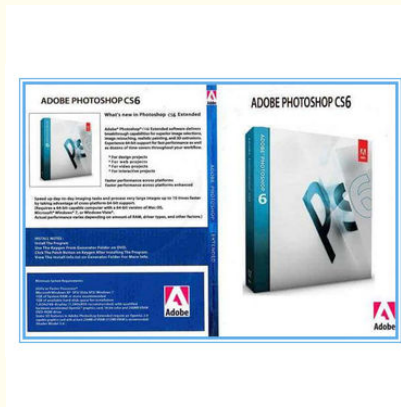

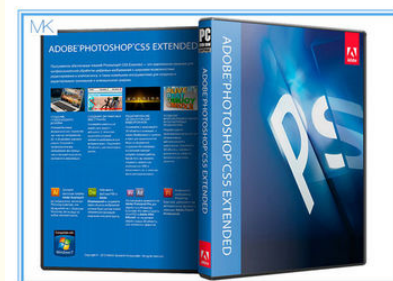

History of Extended CS5:

The name of the company, , comes from Creek in Los Altos, California, which ran behind the houses of both of the company's founders. 's corporate logo features a stylized "A" and was designed by the wife of John Warnock, Marva Warnock, who is a graphic designer.

's first products after PostScript were digital fonts, which they released in a proprietary format called Type 1. Apple subsequently developed a competing standard, TrueType, which provided full scalability and precise control of the pixel pattern created by the font's outlines, and licensed it to Microsoft.

In the mid-1980s, entered the consumer software market with , a vector-based drawing program for the Apple Macintosh. , which grew from the firm's in-house font-development software, helped popularize PostScript-enabled laser printers.

Systems entered NASDAQ in 1986. Its revenue has grown from roughly \$1 billion in 1999 to roughly \$4 billion in 2012. 's fiscal years run from December to November. For example, the 2007 fiscal year ended on November 30, 2007.

In 1989, introduced what was to become its flagship product, a graphics editing program for the Macintosh called . Stable and full-featured, 1.0 was ably marketed by and soon dominated the market.

In 1993, introduced PDF, the Portable Document Format, and its and Reader software. PDF is now an International Standard: ISO 32000-1:2008.

In December 1991, released Premiere, which rebranded as Premiere Pro in 2003. In 1992, acquired OCR Systems, Inc. In 1994, acquired Aldus and added PageMaker and After Effects to its product line later in the year; it also controls the TIFF file format. In 1995, added FrameMaker, the long-document DTP application, to its product line after acquired Frame Technology Corp. In 1996, Systems Inc added Ares Software Corp. In 2002, acquired Canadian company Accelio (also known as JetForm).

On December 12, 2005, acquired its main rival, Macromedia, in a stock swap valued at about \$3.4 billion, adding ColdFusion, Contribute, Captivate, Connect(formerly Macromedia Breeze), Director, Dreamweaver, Fireworks, Flash, FlashPaper, Flex, FreeHand, HomeSite, JRun, Presenter, and Authorware to 's product line.

released Media Player in April 2008. On April 27, discontinued development and sales of its older HTML/web development software, GoLive in favor of Dreamweaver. offered a discount on Dreamweaver for GoLive users and supports those who still use GoLive with online tutorials and migration assistance. On June 1, launched .com, a series of web applications geared for collaborative work.Creative Suite 4, which includes Design, Web, Production Premium and Master Collection came out in October 2008 in six configurations at prices from about USD \$1,700 to \$2,500 or by individual application. The Windows version of includes 64-bit processing.On December 3, 2008, laid off 600 of its employees (8% of the worldwide staff) citing the weak economic environment.

On November 10, 2009, the company laid off a further 680 employees. announced it was investigating a "coordinated attack" against corporate network systems in China, managed by the company.

's 2010 was marked by continuing front-and-back arguments with Apple over the latter's non-support for Flash on its iPhone, iPad and other products.[18] Former Apple CEO Steve Jobs claimed that Flash was not reliable or secure enough, while executives have argued that Apple wish to maintain control over the iOS platform. In April 2010, Steve Jobs published a post titled "Thoughts on Flash" where he outlined his thoughts on Flash and the rise of HTML 5. In July 2010, bought Day Software integrating their line of CQ Products: WCM,DAM,SOCO,and Mobile

In January 2011, acquired DemDex, Inc. with the intent of adding DemDex's audience-optimization software to its online marketing suite. At World 2011, unveiled a new mobile photo service. Carousel is a new application for iPhone, iPad and Mac that uses Lightroom technology for users to adjust and fine-tune images on all platforms. Carousel will also allow users to automatically sync, share and browse photos.The service was later renamed to "Revel". On November 9, 2011, announced that they would cease development of Flash for mobile devices following version 11.1. Instead it would focus on HTML 5 for mobile devices.On December 1, 2011, announced that it entered into a definitive agreement to acquire privately held Efficient Frontier.

In December 2012, opened a new 280,000 square foot corporate campus in Lehi, Utah.

In 2013, Systems endured a major security breach. Vast portions of the source code for the company's software were stolen and posted online and over 150 million records of 's customers have been made readily available for download.In 2012, about 40 million sets of payment card information were compromised by a hack of .

A class-action lawsuit alleging that the company suppressed employee compensation was filed against , and three other Silicon Valley-based companies in a California federal district court in 2013. In May 2014, it was revealed the four companies, , Apple, Google, and Intel had reached agreement with the plaintiffs, 64,000 employees of the four companies, to pay a sum of \$324.5 million to settle the suit.

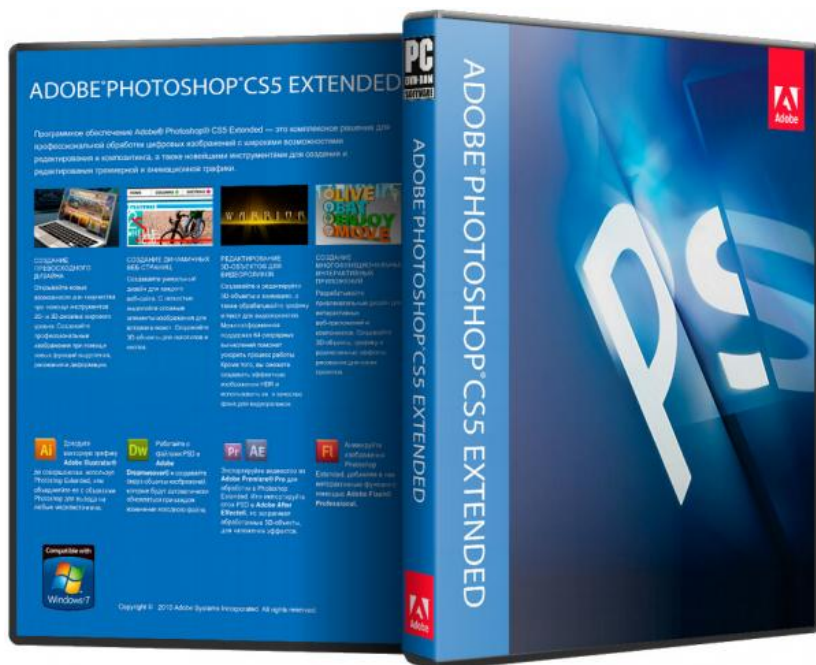
